- Existing oval access to be replaced with concrete steps.
 - Existing bank to be deeply cultivated with added premium topsoil and replanted with hardy native tussocks and groundcovers.
 - Six shade trees planted along the bank.
 - Three picnic tables over concrete pads to be installed under the existing shade trees.
 - Existing planting area to be revitalised to provide a pleasant backdrop to the new picnic and play area.
 - Picnic stailer with picnic table and large concrete pad for large groups and special occasions.
 - Designated fruit tree area adjoining the community garden.
 - A 3m (w) clear path to be maintained along the top of the bank for cross country runs and emergency vehicle access.
 - Large climbing obstacle within an organic softfall area, featuring various sized coloured poles and ropes to provide challenges for all ages.
 - Platform seat surrounded by a community herb garden within the community garden.
 - Community garden with terraced garden beds, central step access and perimeter fence within a colourful planting buffer.

- Paved "Compass" maze with large stone block seals marking the four points of the compass providing a variety of uses for play and orientation, as well as an informal stage for the amphitheater.
- Large concrete amphitheater to make use of the sloping site adjoining Oxford Street, as well as providing an outdoor classroom for students and teachers.
- Two large embankment slides surrounded by wetpour rubber softfall, including rubber access free-form steps, providing a safe play area for large groups.
- Timber lookout/climbing play structure providing another opportunity for interactive play overlooking the oval.
- New concrete access path and steep ramp providing all weather access around the pavilion.
- Climbing wall with wetpour rubber access free-form steps that makes use of the large blank wall of the pavilion.
- Existing slope to be regraded providing a smoother and more consistent slope towards the pavilion.
- Existing concrete access path and retaining walls to be replaced with a new path and masonry retaining wall.
- Existing planting area to be fully removed and replanted with low groundcovers and small shrubs under 500mm.
- New spectator stand with concrete path at the oval level and access steps to each end.
- Existing spectator stand to be upgraded.

- New deck area under the existing tree to be used as an outdoor learning area and a shaded sitting area.
- 2m (w) Concrete access path with stairs to negotiate the steep slope from Oxford Street to the oval with side paths accessing all levels of the pavilion.
- 1.4m (w) Concrete graded ramp providing access for all from Oxford Street, to the oval and all levels of the pavilion.
- Existing playground to be fully replaced with a new and compliant playground including spinner, lookout/climbing structure, balance beams, basket swing, and platform and obstacle challenge course.
- Existing planting area to be fully removed and replanted with low groundcovers.
- Existing vehicle access to be retained for maintenance and emergency vehicle access.
- Existing carpark area to be refinished with a specialist sports pavement with Tennis and Netball court markings added.
- Existing cricket nets to be upgraded.
- Existing vehicle access to be maintained and kept clear of any proposed works.
